

ADLER - BIRD FREE GEL CASE STUDY



Karstadt Building – Hamburg, April 2014



Pigeons had been roosting on the facade of this listed building for many years.

The medical practices on the first and second floors were unable to open their windows due to the smell of the pigeon droppings.



Being a listed building, the local heritage officer would not agree to the use of spikes, wires or nets, while the client wanted a permanent, unobtrusive solution.

The building was cleaned of droppings, and Bird Free was installed.

The client carried out an inspection in February 2020, almost six years after Bird Free was installed.

Although the dishes have become black with pollution the pigeons have not returned. Needless to say, the client is delighted with the results.
